

Law 18-0141, Section M.6.1.7 and M.6.1.8 are added to reflect two (2) new categories of Certified Business Enterprises:</p> <p>M.6.1.7 - Any prime contractor which is a local manufacturing business enterprise (LMBE) certified by the Department of Small and Local Business Development (DSLBD) will receive two additional points on a 100-point scale added to the overall score for proposals submitted by the LMBE in response to this RFP.</p> <p>M.6.1.8 - Any prime contractor which is a veteran-owned business (VOB) certified by the Department of Small and Local Business Development (DSLBD) will receive two additional points on a 100-point scale added to the overall score for proposals submitted by the VOB in response to this RFP.</p> <p>In accordance with the "Department of Small and Local Business Development Amendment Act of 2009", D.C. Law 18-0141, Section M.6.1.3 is amended to reflect that additional points received by any prime contractor that is a longtime resident business (LRB) for that status, are hereby reduced from ten (10) to five (5).</p>
