



1	F.3	It our experience in working on energy assurance plans from other states that a 15-day period is way too short to analyze an existing report and to prepare recommendations. The "recommendations" the contractor will make at this point in the project will become in essence the contractor's "work plan" and a set commitments. Both parties need to be clear about expectations. This deliverable needs to be approached very carefully since it will set the tone for the whole project.		Please see Amendment 0002 Item 3.			
3	F.3	For this deliverable "receipt of required data" is unclear. Clearly, to update the 2005 plan will require data collection and analysis, and the data will have to be collected from several sources, particularly the energy suppliers. It is highly unlikely that a final report can be produced in two weeks since there needs to be a review period by all the stakeholders. Based on our understanding of the DOE guidelines, the District's revision to its energy assurance plan is not due to DOE until February 13, 2011. If our understanding is correct, then a timeline can be developed that will lead to a 2011 delivery date with sufficient review time built in over the next several weeks. 4	F.3	Based on our understanding, the ESDT (tracking plan) is due to DOE on August 12, 2010. We don't see how DDOE is going to receive the plan and send it out to DOE on the same day. If our understanding is correct, and the tracking plan is due to DOE on August 12th, then the deliverable date to DDOE will have to be prior to August 12th. If the contractor has to accelerate the process after the grant is awarded, then there would have to be a contract modification with extra payment to the contractor. This is a fixed price award.
