

## **Attachment A**

### **SOLICITATION NO. DCKA-2010-Q-0121 RESPONSE TO PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS' QUESTIONS**

#### **Question 1**

The spec states (Section 5.2, General Requirements, #1) that "LED beacon units must be designed so that they may be independently aimed at approaching drivers." Our unit contains (2) LED units in each bar. The bar may be aimed but not the (2) individual LED units in each bar. Is this acceptable?

*Response 1* If the bar is aimable independent of the pole, then this is acceptable. But if the bar is aimable only by virtue of how the pole is set in the ground, then no.

#### **Question 2**

The spec states (Section 5.2, General Requirements, #3) that "Push buttons must have audible message alerting pedestrians near the button that the device is available." Can the device play a message continuously to serve this function?

*Response 2* No. The RRFBs will be used in residential neighborhoods and close to residences. A continuously repeating audible message will be an intrusion and annoyance in such situations. The voice message must be activated by the presence of a pedestrian near the RRFB.

#### **Question 3**

The spec states (Section 5.2, General Requirements, #3) that "this must also be able to be activated in Spanish." How would a pedestrian activate to the system to change from English to Spanish?

*Response 3* The preferred method is by holding the button down for 2 seconds. Other methods will be evaluated, if proposed.

#### **Question 4**

The spec states (Section 5.2.1) that "Each RRFB indication shall be a minimum of approximately 5 inches wide by approximately 2 inches high." Our RRFB indication is approximately 4 inches wide by 1.5 inches high. Is this size acceptable?

*Response 4* Yes.
