## Attachment 1

### Questions and Answers

1. **Section 3.2 Suitable Clearances and Minimal Experience Requirements:** The Statement of Work indicates that all “Contractor personnel working on this contact shall have a minimum of secret security clearances.” Is the requirement that the contractor will provide staff with prior security clearance credentials or staff that will be required to obtain a security clearance over the course of the program? Will the District of Columbia sponsor program staff for secret clearance credentials? Would there be a cost to the contractor to cover the security clearance processing?

*Contractors should be able to obtain security clearances, if it becomes necessary. The District of Columbia has no ability to classify information or to issue security clearances.*

2. **Section 4.0 Deliverables:** Is there an expectation that during the Base Period Deliverable phase of the program that the overall duration of this phase will last approximately one year, depending on the pace of solutions procurement and the ability to integrate the solution into the operational environment? Some of the identified deliverables can be performed simultaneously but will be impacted by the time required to finalize programs.

*The level of effort is estimated to be one year for the base year.*

3. **Section 4.4 Installation and Configuration Management:** At paragraph 4.4.1, can it be interpreted that the Contractor will work with the solution vendors and the selected National Capital Region (NCR) Information Technology (IT) department(s) to “fully configure the detection and alert software in the development environment...” It would appear that these “partners” will be critical to achieve this objective.

*The issue here is that the contractor demonstrate a knowledge of interoperability requirements of the NCR, and yes these partners will be critical to the success of the system that is why we need assistance managing them.*

*The contract will have a firm-fixed price base year.*
