

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The Government of the District of Columbia (District) Office of Contracting and Procurement (OCP) on behalf of The Office of Unified Communications is requesting the services of a contractor to provide radio batteries.

The task order proposal should be prepared according to the instructions listed below:

**1. Proposal Submission Requirements**

The task order proposal shall be submitted in a sealed envelope conspicuously marked: "Task Order Proposal in response to Solicitation No.

All proposals must be submitted on 8.5" by 11" paper and typewritten. Electronic and fax submission of proposals will not be accepted, unless otherwise directed in writing.

**2. Technical Proposal**

This section shall be submitted under a separate cover titled "**Technical Proposal**". The technical portion shall, at a minimum:

- a. Provide a descriptive list of batteries
- b. Describe the offeror's experience with providing similar products to the District of Columbia or similar sized public organization.

### 3. Price Proposal

This section shall be submitted under a separate cover titled "**Price Proposal**". It shall include the total price for the entire project, and shall be broken down by each product as set forth in the statement of work. Pricing shall be a firm fixed price and shall identify all costs. Unless otherwise directed in writing, the price proposal shall, at a minimum include:

- a. Identify the total price, and include a summary of all items proposed.
- c. Completed Price Schedule, **Attachment B**.
- d. Copy of Offer's GSA Price Schedule.

Offerors shall also complete and return the Tax Certification Affidavit, **Attachment C**.

Therefore, each initial offer should contain the Offeror's best terms from a fixed price basis.
