N95 Respirator Procurement

The Government of the District of Columbia, Department of Health (DOH), Health Emergency Preparedness and Response Administration (HEPRA) is seeking a contract to purchase 3M Health Care 1860 S (small) N95 particulate respirators, and 3M Health Care 1860 R (Regular) N95 particulate respirators, to stockpile for DC and National Capital Region (NCR) emergency response operations.

Period of Performance is from date of award through May 31, 2011.

DOH is responsible for developing and maintaining operational capacity for its Strategic National Stockpile (SNS), Cities Readiness Initiative (CRI), and Pandemic Influenza response programs as a requirement of the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) Cooperative Agreement. In order to support response capability and ensure that DC healthcare providers are able to remain operational in an emergency, DOH stockpiles N-95 particulate respirators for emergency use. It is of the utmost importance that healthcare workers be adequately protected with personal protective equipment (PPE) to provide a layer of defense against infectious agents and other elements that may harm these individuals while caring for the sick and injured. DOH must stockpile adequate amounts of N95 respirators for healthcare professionals to offer basic protection to health care workers and patients during emergency events where there would be potential exposure to an infectious agent.

The contractor shall provide the following N-95 respirators to HEPRA related to this procurement.
